

Mount Morgan is a picturesque historic town nestled in the Dee Ranges, situated approximately 38 km south west of Rockhampton.

Rich in history, the former mining town is home to one of the world's most successful mines to date. Commencing operation in 1882, the mine became one of the richest gold mines in Australia, and for a period of time - the world.

The town offers ideal opportunities to delve into the area's early successes and relive its fascinating past with a range of impressive attractions on show, along with museums and tours operating 7 days a week.

TOP 5 FACTS

- During its 99 years of mining the area declared a total of 252 ton of gold, 37 ton of silver and 360 ton of copper
- The Mafeking Bell was cast at the Mount Morgan Mine in 1900 made from copper pennies
- Mount Morgan Mine is heritage listed, however the site is not currently accessible to the public
- The Frank Golding Lookout in East Street is the highest lookout and a great photo opportunity
- The Arthur Timms Lookout in Pattison Street is the closest view of the mine site
